The official Boy Scout/Venturing uniform (Class"A") is required to be worn throughout the course week. All insignia must be sewn in the correct position according to the current Scout Handbook. The Scout Activity (Class "B") uniform, which is a Scouting related T-shirt, official Scout shorts, and Scout belt, is worn during the heat of the day. A Scout baseball style cap is recommended. Merit Badge and OA sashes are not needed or worn. Scout's name should be on each item he/she brings. Do NOT bring electronics, they are not needed. In the case of an emergency, the staff will provide necessary communication. Each Scout must arrive in correct official (Class "A") uniform, and will backpack from the check-in area to the campsite. No luggage or foot lockers! Each patrol will back-pack to an overnight campsite during the course. Any Scout not having the required items and a signed, current Personal Health and Medical Form, and who is not 1st Class or Venturer (or a waiver from the Course Director) and whose fees are not paid in full, may not, under BSA policies and guidelines, be admitted to the course.
