

Brownsea NYLT Personal Equipment List

The official Boy Scout uniform (Class "A") is required to be worn throughout the course week. All insignia must be sewn in the correct position according to the current Boy Scout Handbook. The Boy Scout Activity (Class "B") uniform, consisting of a Scouting related T-shirt, official Scout shorts, and Scout belt, is worn during the heat of the day. **A Scout baseball style cap is required (Troop caps are OK). Merit Badge and OA sashes are not needed or worn.** Participants will need two (2) uniforms so that they may wash a uniform each day. Scout's name should be on each item he brings. He may use laundry detergent (something like Spray 'n Wash also helps).

Do NOT bring anything electronic such as games or phones. ONE exception to this is battery-powered fans due to the summer heat.

Each Scout must arrive in correct official (Class "A") uniform, and he will backpack from the check-in area to his campsite. No luggage or footlockers!!

Each patrol will back-pack to an overnight campsite during the course.

Any Scout not having the required items and a signed, current Personal Health and Medical Form, and who is not 1st Class (or a waiver from the Course Director) and whose fees are not paid in full, may not, under BSA policies and guidelines, be admitted to the course.

Required Items

- Ballpoint pens & pencils (for taking notes)
- Uniform shirt (short sleeves) with correct insignia (2)
- Scout T-shirts (3)
- Uniform shorts (2 pairs)
- Uniform headgear of your troop
- Uniform socks (3 pairs)
- Official belt and buckle (1)
- Shoes suitable for hiking
- Change of shoes, as desired
- Raincoat, poncho, or rain suit
- Handkerchiefs (as needed)
- Underclothing (3 sets, minimum)
- Laundry soap
- Backpack
- Small day pack/book bag for daily use (for rain gear/books/water)
- Lightweight tent
- Ground cloth (waterproof)
- Air mattress or foam pad
- Sleeping bag or blankets
- Compass
- Plate, bowl, and drinking cup
- Knife, fork, and spoon
- Canteen or water bottle

- Pocket knife (no non-folding sheath knives)
- Totin' Chip
- Flashlight w/spare batteries
- Towels (2)
- Washcloths (2)
- Personal sewing kit
- Personal first aid kit
- Tooth brush and toothpaste
- Hand soap & container
- Insect repellent
- Sunscreen/lip balm
- Comb
- Boy Scout Handbook
- Patrol Leader Handbook
- Prescribed medication

Optional Items

- Sharpening stone
- Watch
- Sunglasses
- Uniform socks (2 additional pair)
- Religious books
- Pillow/case
- Camera with extra film
- Moccasins or slippers
